- 8. Horses will be demonstrated and sold in the same order.

- 11. All horses leaving Perlich Bros. Auction Market Ltd. will require a horse permit to leave the facility. This will be obtained from a brand inspector in the LIS office at Perlich Bros. Auction Market.
